Contest Reminders



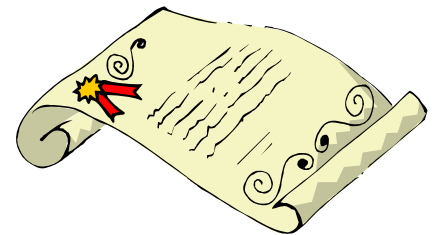
The Contest Rules are included in this Newsletter. Be sure that your kids sign up for the Quiz Competition, the more students taking the quiz, the better your chances at a higher team score. Be sure to review the updated rules in the Ankle Taping Contest. Remember, one boy and one girl per school. Also, have your school enter a kit in the Kit Stocking Competition. Explain to your kids the Poster Presentation needs to catch the eyes of the judges, now only visual but quality of the subject. "Alternate Subjects of Athletic Training" would be a great theme for the poster entries this year, in addition to the usual rehabilitation and explanations of injuries.

Constitution Change

During the Business Meeting, be prepared to hear the proposed changes to our Constitution. In order for us to become tax-exempt, our "Purpose" needs to be restated/reworded.

The "Purpose" presently states:

1. To promote the highest possible standards for Athletic Trainers.
2. To promote the advancement of the athletic training profession in all its phases, and to promote a better working relationship among those persons interested in the care and prevention of athletic injuries, and in the education and well being of all athletes.
3. To promote the free exchange of ideas within the association to further the ability of its members.



The "Purpose" must first be stated:

1. *To promote educational and charitable opportunity for all Student Trainers. (Must be added)*
2. To promote the highest possible standards for Athletic Trainers and the free exchange of ideas within the association to further the ability of its members.
3. To promote the advancement of the athletic training profession in all its phases, and to promote a better working relationship among those persons interested in the care and prevention of athletic injuries, and in the education and well being of all athletes.

I honestly do not see a problem with this proposed change passing, but in order for the Constitution to be changed, the issue must be voted on and passed by 2/3 vote at the annual business meeting.
